

Debt Resolution





Our Approach

Expert debt recovery for business in four steps at fixed costs.



Phase 1 – Pre-Action Letter

Our letter will request immediate payment of the outstanding debt.

Upon instruction we will:

1. Provide you with a draft letter.
2. Finalise and send out a letter.
3. Receive payments on your behalf and forward any correspondence received.



Phase 2 – Issue

If we do not receive payment after our Pre-Action Letter, we will issue a claim on your behalf.

Our costs of issuing the claim will be based on the value of the debt beneficiaries (up to 4) and dividing your estate equally or unequally between beneficiaries (up to 4).



Phase 3 – Judgement

Upon the debtor either admitting the outstanding debt or failing to defend or acknowledge your claim, we will request a judgment on your behalf.

If your matter becomes contested, your matter will be referred to our dispute resolution department.



Phase 4 – Enforcement

If you have obtained judgment and the debtor has failed to settle the debt, we will provide you with options and next steps as to how to enforce judgment.

Our Costs

Phase 1 – Pre-Action Letter

Additional Option

Sending a chaser letter after 14 days

Costs: £30 +VAT (per debtor)

Phase 3 – Judgement

£5000-£10,000	£455	£350
£10,000-£50,000	5% of the claimed value	£500

Phase 4 – Enforcement

Based on the value of the claim*:

Warrant of Control	£83	£150
Writ of Control	£71	£200
Charging Order	£119	£400
Attachment of Earnings Order	£119	£300 + £100 per hearing
Order to Attend Court for Questioning	£59	£150
Third Party Debt Order	£400	£150
Statutory Demand	No fee	£400

*Note the above fees do not include additional disbursements incurred such as service of documents.
